Walt Rothwell investigated how much it would cost the church to move the power pole behind the Sanctuary. As we are in discernment about staying or going, it was felt that we should gather information about this in case expanding the Sanctuary was chosen. Walt found that there is no longer a cost associated with moving power underground. We would simply need to provide a small amount of conduit and a cement slab. This was informational only and no further action is required.

Greg Turosak said the Board has the position of no major updates to the building until a stay/go vote is made. Therefore, there are no budgetary items to add at this time.

Erika Fetterman gave Waste Management notice of discontinuation of service and Hometown Haulers will now be our service provider beginning March 8, 2022.
