The two larger "flex" rooms could be for overflow or for those needing a smaller or quieter environment, but still not too distant from sanctuary. Looks like they could be separate or joined as needed. They could be a more intimate chapel for more smaller events. There are two additional flex rooms - would assume one for the library and one for whatever need there is (a room for large projects or ongoing projects, a room for adult programs instead of always having to use the sanctuary, or a room for families whose children do not wish to go to RE but still need the space to spread out and talk a bit with a window into the sanctuary and sound?
